

Degree Condition

Your admission is conditioned upon your having received a bachelor's degree prior to enrollment. The only exceptions are for students seeking admittance via the 90+ Program or a 3+3 Program

Financial Aid

Applicants should apply for financial aid as soon as possible after December 1, 2025. You should apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Our Title IV School Code is **002518**. If you are a Summer Start student, you will also need to file a FAFSA for the 2025-2026 year for summer loans. If you have already filed with your undergraduate institution, make sure you have added UMKC as a recipient. If you require a paper application, please contact the UMKC Financial Aid Office at finaid@umkc.edu. Seat Deposit

Two \$250.00 non-refundable deposits are required to ensure your seat in the school's 2026 entering class. The full amount will be credited toward your tuition bill. For both Summer and Fall Start students, the first \$250.00 will be due April 1. For Summer Start students, the second \$250 seat deposit is due May 1. For Fall Start students, the second \$250 is due May 15. Follow this link to pay your seat deposits law.umkc.edu/seatdeposit.

Orientation

Please mark your calendar to attend the **mandatory** Orientation and Matriculation Program: May 19-21, 2026 (Summer Start Program) and August 17-20, 2026 (Fall Start Program). Additional details will be sent to you in the months prior to Orientation.

Enrollment

Enrollment will occur in late April for Summer Start students and in June for Fall Start students. At that time, you will be instructed to enroll in the courses and sections you have been assigned.

The Law School must receive the official transcript showing your degree before Orientation.
