Letter to Councilperson or Mayor Information Sheet

As part of your Kansas City Youth Court Sentence, you have been ordered to complete the following rehabilitative activity for your community.

Look around your neighborhood and make a list of problems you would like to see the city of Kansas City do something about. Maybe there is trash on the ground, bad lighting, street signs missing, dangerous sidewalks, abandoned houses or cars that you notice. Perhaps you think that your neighborhood is missing services like laundromats, grocery stores or parks and basketball courts for kids. Think about what you can do to help make your block better. Ask your friends and family what they think should be included in your list of things that could make your neighborhood better. Then write a letter to your Councilperson and the Mayor telling them the things you noticed and any ideas you have for improving your neighborhood.


